

## Scholarships at the University of Cambridge:

All applicants who wish to apply for scholarships from the Cambridge Trust must apply for admission to the University of Cambridge by the relevant funding deadline. Only those applicants who **have been offered** a conditional place to study at the University can be considered for a scholarship.

Where there is a separate application required, it is imperative that the process is aligned to the University of Cambridge's timetable below.

### TIMETABLE FOR APPLICATIONS

<b>September</b>	The University's <a href="#">Applicant Portal</a> opens for applications
<b>December or January (according to course)</b>	<a href="#">Deadline</a> for receipt of online applications via the Applicant Portal for students applying for funding.
<b>January- March</b>	<a href="#">Offers</a> of admission are made by the Graduate Admissions office
<b>March- July</b>	<p>Most funding awards are made between the beginning of March and the end of July with the majority of awards being made in March and April.</p> <p>During this period;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The Cambridge Trust draws up shortlists of eligible candidates who have received offers of conditional admission to send to scholarship funding partners (where applicable) to consider for their awards.</li> <li>2) Funding partners consider applications, in some cases hold interviews, and inform the Trust of their preferred candidates.</li> <li>3) Offers of awards are sent to successful applicants.</li> </ol>
<b>July- September</b>	Successful applicants receive <a href="#">Confirmation</a> of Acceptance for Studies and can start making arrangements to come into residence at the University of Cambridge from October.

**Important:**

- 1) Scholarships cannot be transferred from one academic year to the next, and must be taken up at the beginning of one of the academic terms in the year of award, i.e. at the beginning of **October, January or April**. For entry from January or April, permission needs to be given by the relevant Department/Faculty, College and the Graduate Admissions Office.
- 2) Please notify the Cambridge Trust as soon as possible, the date and deadlines of any calls for applications that are separate from the University's application process.
- 3) Advise the Cambridge Trust of your preferred award winners between March and July or as soon as possible.
